He received 6 days of intense chemotherapy (3-5 times the strength of what he received previously during his 5 cycles at Hasbro Children's Hospital). On Day 0 (Transplant Day 🙌👤), he received his own stem cells; which were previously extracted and frozen at BCH.

The last 9 days have been a series of ups and downs;... dealing with the after effects of the chemotherapy drugs he was given. Davis, being the little fighter that he is, continues to push through the challenges of this journey as his stem cells try to kick into action. 🙌👤

I won't share the hard stuff with you all. However, I will celebrate the positives; the little victories we continue to hold onto as he pushes his way forward. The doctors, nurses, and staff continue to be pleased (and sometimes surprised) by Davis' strength and perseverance. He's definitely been more tired the last 3 days; but that hasn't stopped him from getting out of bed to walk to the bathroom on his own- according to the professionals, this is one of those small victories that we celebrate! 🙌👤 Davis also continues to make a little time to be funny (whether he knows it or not), act silly, watch tv, and play in his room- another victory in our book! 🙌👤 We can only hope that he continues to keep his spirits up; as he has throughout his whole road to recovery thus far.
