If you happen to lose this booklet, you can also find it on the school website, along with the third grade reading list from the Warwick Public Library. Mercy Watson is the required book, but I hope you will read several other books or stories, poems, and magazine or newspaper articles as well. You may record the name of each book, poem, story, or magazine or newspaper article you read on the reading log I am attaching. Some books take longer than others, so there is no total amount you need to read. You do not need to choose from the Warwick list, since this list contains only suggestions. Hopefully, though, you will be reading **something** almost every day and logging in what you have read.

Please bring the completed comprehension booklet and reading log back to school on the first day of third grade. Students who bring their booklet back on the first day will receive a reading prize! On the first day, you should also bring back your Summer Solutions book.
