Dear Grade Seven Parents,

This letter is regarding the **Peanut/Tree Nut allergy condition and restrictions in your child's classroom.**

The child/children in question have a severe allergy that could be life threatening. The welfare and safety of our entire student body is of utmost concern to all of us in the Saint Peter Tri-Parish School family. **Snack foods for students in Grade Eight must be entirely nut free.** We are passing along to you today a few suggestions for snack foods that fit the nut free description: **Goldfish Crackers, Fruit Snacks, Teddy Grahams, fresh fruits and vegetables, Cereal Bars, Granola Bites.** We hope these suggestions are of help to you when packing snacks.

The students in Grade Seven eat lunch in the cafeteria. If you pack anything in the lunch box/bag that contains nut products the entire lunch box/bag must go directly to the school office or a container placed outside of the classroom. Your child will retrieve the box/bag just before going down to lunch.

There are many food products that contain various forms of peanuts/tree nuts/coconuts. We will not allow sharing of snacks or lunches. Please reinforce this with your children at home.
