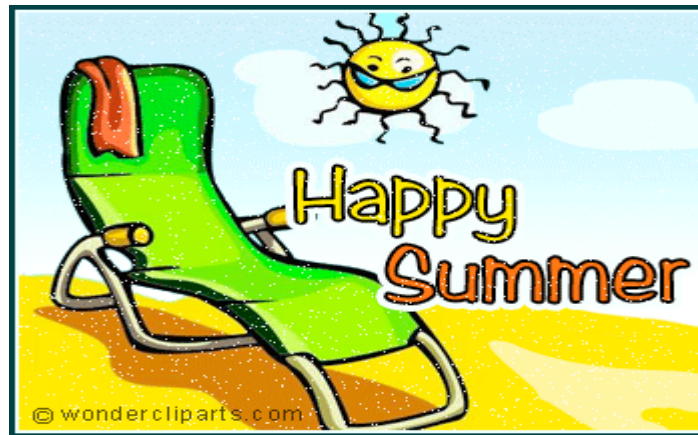

FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION FORM (K-5): With this letter, you will find the **First Day of School Transportation Form**. **Please fill this out and return it to school on the first day, Tuesday, September 5th**. By having this form in hand, teachers will know how your child is getting home on the first day of school and most future days. **If there is a change in the normal way a child goes home, note or phone call is required**. In the event that no one is here to pick up your child, or you are late for pick up, he/she will automatically be **sent to Extended Day** and you will be **billed accordingly**.

SCHOOL BUS STOPS: Stops will be posted, by school name, in the **Warwick Beacon** toward the **middle of August**. **We do not assign the stops for our students**. This is handled by the **Warwick School Transportation Department**.

Bus passes will be handed out to your child at the **end of the first day of class**. They should keep these securely in their lunch bags. **Any requests for changes to bus stops must be made with Mrs. Rossi**.

TUITION: Your first tuition payment was due on July 1st in accordance with the tuition contract you signed. If you have not received your bill/statement from the Parish Office, you can drop off a payment at the school office. Your second monthly payment, if you selected the 10 or 12 payment plan, was due on August 1st. If you elected to pay in full, for grades K-8 only, you can still deduct \$100.00 from your total payment. If you decided on the 2 payments, your first payment was due July 1st. All unpaid balances for tuition, Mandatory Fundraising and Extended Day from the previous school year must be paid in full before your child is removed from the waiting list for the upcoming school year. Please call Mrs. Rossi if you have any questions.
